This extraordinary broodmare has produced six wonderful purebred Irish Draught foals, five sired by Mountain Pearl, and the youngest sired by Silver Granite. The oldest four have all passed RID inspections with excellent scores – one a stallion, and three mares. The other two, a stallion prospect and a filly have not yet been presented. Alanna is sound and healthy and obviously misses being a mother.

Loguestown Classic

Veterinary, breeding & foaling history:

- Alanna is easy to handle for exams and veterinary activities including shots.
- Fresh semen used for first 5 foals and she generally took on the first try.
- 2009 foal was bred from 15 year old untested frozen semen from the deceased stallion Silver Granite and she settled with the first insemination.
- All pregnancies resulted in live foal except one which she aborted at 5 months in 2003. Iowa State Veterinary School Hospital did an examination of the fetus and found no obvious defect or cause for the loss. Mare was treated with antibiotics and flushed a number of times. She was successfully bred the next spring and has had no subsequent problems.
- Alanna has always foaled unassisted and without incident. She is a loving mother and does allow people to handle her and the foal. Mare suffered a slight case of foal colic after the 2003 foaling where part of her colon moved into the space just vacated by the foal and did require veterinary care. She was treated with fluids and within a couple days everything moved back into place. She was cooperative with the vets and technicians despite her discomfort and worry about her newborn foal. (No worry was needed. The filly quickly learned how to nurse from her laying down dam.). There has been no hint of a recurrence with subsequent foalings and all vets we talked to said it was a quirk that sometimes happens and is not related to conformation or health.
